

## **Pupil Premium Funding 2015 - 2016**

### **What is Pupil Premium?**

Pupil Premium is additional funding allocated to pupils entitled to Free School Meals (FSM) and those who have been eligible for Free School Meals at any point in the last six years (Ever 6), children from Forces families and looked after children (LAC). From the strategies and interventions we will implement we would expect that eligible pupils will:

- Improve their level of attainment and progress individually, against their peers and against national averages.
- Have full access to the curriculum.
- Have a noticeably enhanced level of resilience for the next stage of their education

The school currently has 39 eligible for the funding and the school will receive £45,020 (as of Sept 2015).

### **How will the school spend the 2015 - 2016 allocation to achieve its objectives?**

This year plans are in place to:

- Provide intervention activities & specialist support in Reading, Writing and Maths & dedicated attainment tracking.
- Provide resources for all support and intervention groups.
- Work in partnership with specialist agencies to provide emotional and social support.
- Support parental engagement.
- Fund trips, visits, extra-curricular clubs and activities for all Pupil Premium children and in addition swimming lessons for Year 2 PPG children.
- Offer milk daily to all Pupil Premium children.
- Offer support in providing school uniform.

### **How will we know if Pupil Premium children's attainment has improved?**

Dedicated meetings are held each term with class teachers and Senior Management to discuss individual progress and monitor intervention strategies. Attainment & Progress of Pupil Premium children is reported to Governors each term.
