

## Pupil Premium Impact Statement 2015 - 2016

### Impact

The following provides information relating to the impact of the above spending on children who are eligible for PPG (including PPG children who are SEND).

<b>Year Group</b>	<b>Commentary</b>
<b>Reception</b>	79% of pupils made a good level of development (GLD) at the end of Foundation Stage. The majority of pupils eligible for PPG made at least good progress (based on in-house tracking)
<b>Year 1</b>	60% of PPG children attained the threshold score for the Year 1 phonics screening check
<b>Year 2</b>	63% of pupils eligible for PPG met EXP+ or above at the end of Key Stage 1 in reading.  38% of pupils eligible for PPG met EXP+ or above at the end of Key Stage 1 in maths.  56% of pupils eligible for PPG met EXP+ or above at the end of Key Stage 1 in writing.  The majority of children eligible for PPG made expected progress or above from their starting points based on in-house tracking at the beginning of Year 2 in reading, writing and maths.
