Impact

The following provides information relating to the impact of the above spending on children who are eligible for PPG (including PPG children who are SEND).

Year Group	Commentary
Reception	33% of pupils eligible for PPG made a good level of development (GLD) at the end of Foundation Stage. The majority of pupils eligible for PPG made at least good progress (based on in-house tracking)
Year 1	62% of PPG children attained the threshold score for the Year 1 phonics screening check
Year 2	64% of pupils eligible for PPG met EXP+ or above at the end of Key Stage 1 in reading. 71% of pupils eligible for PPG met EXP+ or above at the end of Key Stage 1 in maths. 29% of pupils eligible for PPG met EXP+ or above at the end of Key Stage 1 in writing. The majority of children eligible for PPG made expected progress or above from their starting points based on in-house tracking at the beginning of Year 2 in reading, writing and maths.
