Impact

The following provides information relating to the impact of the above spending on children who are eligible for PPG (including PPG children who are SEND).

Year Group	Commentary
Reception	<i>50% made a Good Level of Development (GLD) at the end of Foundation Stage. 100% made the same or better progress as those children who were not in receipt of the PPG (based on in-house tracking)</i>
Year 1	<i>60% attained the threshold score for the Year 1 phonics screening check</i>
Year 2	<i>54% made the expected standard or above for Reading, Writing and Maths at the end of Key Stage 1 100% made the same or better progress from their starting points as those children who were not in receipt of the PPG (based on in-house tracking)</i>
