## Year 7 admission to The Tiffin Girls' School

Message from Ian Keary, Headteacher at Tiffin Girls' School: I wanted to take this opportunity to share with you a summary of our Year 7 admissions process and invite your Year 5 children to our upcoming Open Evening on Tuesday 9 July, from 4.30pm.

If any of your Year 5 parents would like to register their daughter for our admissions tests for Year 7 entry, the registration link is now open on the <u>school website</u> until Monday 2 September 2024, 12.00 noon. I am particularly keen to encourage your disadvantaged children to register – pupil premium or service premium children who live in our catchment area, and looked after or previously looked after children – as they will receive priority in our selection criteria. We apply a 10% leeway to the scores of disadvantaged children in all testing stages in order to support their application.
