Road Safety

This week new banners about car idling have been put up in Gothic and Third Cross Roads. Idling can result in increasing air pollution around our schools, so your co-operation is appreciated if you can turn off your car engine, and help increase the air quality around our schools. Thank you.

Thank you for being considerate when bringing your children to school and picking them up every day, and not parking over residents' dropped kerbs, on the double yellow lines, or zig zag lines. There are parking bays in the surrounding roads, or even, park a little further out and walk in.

Children born between 1.9.20 and 31.8.21

If you have a child born between 1.9.20 and 31.8.21 you need to apply for a place for him/her to start in Reception in September 2025. Go to www.richmond.gov.uk and click on School Admissions. Closing date for applications is 15 January 2025. You need to apply even if you already have an older child attending Trafalgar Schools. Y2 Children

Parents/Carers of children in Y2 need to apply for a place for their child to move to Trafalgar Junior School in September 2025. Go to www.richmond.gov.uk and click on School Admissions. Closing date for applications is 15 January 2025 Although this is just a formality, all families must complete the form.

School Admissions

Admission authorities are required to consult on their admission arrangements for the academic year 2026/27 either when changes are proposed, or at least once every seven years even if no changes have been made.

Please see the link for the public consultation on the admission arrangements for the academic year 2026/27. The closing date for comments is 6 January 2025 (at 5pm).

The proposal is to reduce the forms of entry from 3 form (90 pupils) to 2 form (60 pupils) as well as amending the criterial for over subscription. The proposal is to give a higher priority for children currently in the Infants school wishing to join the Junior School, followed by priority for children of staff members.
